# RAFFLE BLOCK OF THE MONTH 

## MARCH 2018

## BLOCK-FRAMED FOUR PATCH

SIZE- $10^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$ finished ( $10 \frac{1}{2}^{\prime} \times 10 \frac{1}{2}^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished)
FABRIC CHOICES- white for the inside frame strip and any assorted fabrics for the squares and outer strip choosing at least one green fabric (think St. Patrick's Day)

CUTTING- WOF $=$ width of fabric selvedge to selvedge white (solid or looks like a solid)- $12^{\prime \prime} \times 25$ " strip

Sub cut into $22^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2}^{\prime \prime}$ strips and $22^{\prime \prime} \times 7 \frac{1}{2}^{\prime \prime}$ strips
Assorted fabrics-4 $2 \frac{1^{\prime \prime}}{} \times 2 \frac{1^{\prime \prime}}{2}$ squares
one fabric-
1 2" $\times$ WOF strip sub cut into $22^{\prime \prime} \times 7 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips and $22^{\prime \prime} \times 10 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ strips

SEWING- please use a $\frac{1}{4}$ "seam allowance and a 2 mm stitch

1. Four Patch- sew 2 pairs of squares together, press seams to one side sew the pair together butting the seams
2. Inside Frame- sew the two white $4 \frac{1^{\prime \prime}}{}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the opposite sides of the four patch units, press towards the white strips
Sew the $7 \frac{1}{2}^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the top and bottom and press towards the white.
3. Outside Frame- sew the $7 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ strips to opposite sides of the framed unit following the same pattern as the white strips, press towards the outer strips
Sew the $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips to the top and bottom and press towards the outer strips.

## PROJECT IDEAS-

16 squares baby quilt ( $40^{\prime \prime} \times 40^{\prime \prime}$ )
30 squares lap size ( $50^{\prime \prime} \times 60^{\prime \prime}$ )
56 twin ( $70 \times \times 90$ ")
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
