MAY RAFFLE BLOCK PRAIRIE QUEEN

This block is due for drawing at the May, 2014 Meeting


A traditional block for our last of the season & our tenure.

Fabric Requirements -

Need a light, dark, medium and off white background ANY combination of colors.

Cutting the Pieces --

Dark	Qty 2	4" squares
Light –	Qty 1	3 ¹ /2" square
Medium –	Qty 1	2″ strip at least 16″ long
Off white –	Qty 2	4" squares
	Qty 1	2" strip at least 16" long



Piecing Squares—

Place dark and background squares right sides together, draw diagonal Line corner to corner and sew $\frac{1}{4}$ seams both sides of line, cut on line. Open and press toward dark. Cut down to 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ square.

Piecing Strips –

Sew medium and background strips together lengthwise. Press toward medium. Cut double strip in 2" sections. Sew into 4 patch blocks, qty 4.





Layout -- Place squares as shown below – Note 4 patch orientation.



Final Assembly --

Sew rows – press top and bottom to outside, middle toward center. Sew rows together.

As usual, the more you make the more chances to win. Have fun, good luck at the drawing.
