Block of the Month May 2019

This block is fun and easy to make and allows for many different patterns when put together.

Cut 3 1/2'' squares of black and white from a 3 1/2'' wide strip. For each 6'' block layer a white block on a black block 2 times. Draw a diagonal across the white blocks and sew 4' on either side of the line. Cut on the line. You will have now have 4 black/white half square triangles. Press seams to dark side and trim to 2 $\frac{1}{2''}$.

Cut two 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares from the black strip. Cut a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square from a dark blue and two 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares from a light blue.

Sew the squares into a nine patch arranging the colors as shown.
