## **Thread Painting Workshop**

### **Supplies for Everyone:**

1. Sewing machine with a free motion or open toe foot.
2. Optional: Sew Steady Extension Table
3. Three: 12 x 12-inch square sandwich for practice: Fabric top, batting, stabilizer, backing. You need to be able to see your stitches on the fabric.
4. Basting spray, large safety pins, small scissors, tweezers, Optional: Supreme Slider and quilting gloves
5. Needles: Topstitch or embroidery size 10, 11 & 12
6. Iron and Ironing mat
7. Cutting mat and rotary cutter.
8. Bobbin Thread: I use a soft shade of gray. Some people like to match the top spool
9. Thread: I primarily use a 40-wt. embroidery thread. But use what you have
  - Bring colors that match what you plan on thread painting – see below

**Options:** Bring a fabric panel of your choice, batting, stabilizer, backing, cutting mat, rotary cutter. Tread should match the fabric of the panel plus a variety of colors that are lighter or darker in shade.

OR

Purchase a Kit from me:

I will be bringing kits that can be purchased the night of the lecture of the day of the workshop. Prices vary for \$10 to \$75

You will need to bring various shades of thread that you find on a color wheel – I would wait till you purchase a kit to match the thread.
