Liberated Houses Workshop Supply List

This is a fun workshop with very little prep and lots of sewing fun! I will demonstrate techniques for making liberated house blocks in different styles and sizes. This is a fun way to use scraps or make a holiday or themed quilt. I will discuss how to set the blocks to finish your house quilt.

Full Day Workshop

Basic Sewing Supplies:

- ___ Fabric Scissors (large and small)
- ___ Rotary Cutter and Mat
- ___ Rotary Ruler - at least 6"
- ___ Paper and pencil for notes and sketching
- ___ Sewing Machine in good working order **with all cords.**
- ___ thread and seam ripper
- ___ Heat and Bond Fusible if you want to add applique' (not required)
- ___ Irons and boards to share.

Fabric Requirements:

Scraps in all sizes of your favorite colors. This project is perfect for novelties prints. A good mix of lights, darks and different prints work well for these houses.

1½ " - 3" inch scrap strips work well

½ to 1 yard for background (sky) or very large scraps

6 - 8 Fat Quarters or larger pieces for roofs and backgrounds

When possible, I bring a lot of scraps to share.
