

Quilt Sizes and Patterns Documentation

Quilt sizes

Throw 50 x60 - For all ages

Twin 70 x 90 - For all ages

Baby 36 x 40

Premi 30 x 30

Double/Full 80 x 88 – occasional request

Pillowcases

For a standard pillow size using the 'Hotdog' method you will need two pieces of cotton or flannel fabric. Cut one 9 inches x wof for the cuff and one 27 inches x wof (wof = with if fabric) for the body. The following link is a pdf that walks you through how to make the pillow case. (Note the measurements for the fabric are slightly different in the PDF. Our measurements allow you to get two pillowcases from two yards of fabric.)
